2) Using Office Online and its Web Apps (Word, Excel, PowerPoint)

- Using existing Word and PowerPoint styles.
- Creating and formating a spreadsheet with Excel Online.
- Working with data tables and creating graphs.
- Using different copying options: basic operations and functions.
- Limitations of Office Online.

Hands-on work: Create documents with Web Apps and use different styles. Design a table and use the data. Create a graph. Create a survey or a poll with Excel.

3) Creating and sharing an interactive web panel with Sway

- Adding text, images and other content.
- Searching for and importing relevant content from other sources.
